

Summary of 'This Week with Huzoor' – 19 May 2023

“Masha-Allah! With such lofty aspirations, one can indeed become a source of delight for the Khalifa’s eyes,” was part of the reply from Huzoor(aba) to **a question asked by a married Lajna member who said she was not Waqifa-e-Nau but how could she contribute to the Jama’at and be the delight of the Khalifa’s eyes?**

Huzoor(aba) said it did not matter if she was a Waqf as even before the establishment of the Waqf-e-Nau scheme, people had already dedicated their lives in order to serve the Jama’at & cited his own example as such. Huzoor(aba) further explained that when Lajna members actively engage in various fields within the Jama’at, participate in Tabligh activities, adhere to the teachings of the Promised Messiah(as) and acquire knowledge of the Holy Qur’an, Hadith and Islam, they are already actively serving Islam.

A question was asked to Huzoor(aba) that can the upbringing of children have a negative effect on children if a married couple prioritise their individual desires over each other's rights?

Huzoor(aba) gave a detailed reply but basically said: *“It is not a matter of prioritising each other; it is a matter of showing respect to each other. So, if husband and wife both realise their duties, then it will never happen that [one will think] ‘I am superior to you, or you are inferior to me,’ or ‘I am superior to you and you are inferior to me.’”* Parents should basically discharge their duties in line with Islamic teachings.

One lady also asked Huzoor(aba) whether it was right for a woman to consider herself an equal partner in marriage?

Huzoor (aba) answered: *“It is quite right that you are equal partners, as long as your rights are concerned, your freedom is concerned, & your liberty is concerned. Yes, you have equal rights; but, at the same time, Islam has allocated some assignments to both the husband and the wife.”* Huzoor(aba) went on to say: *“If both realise their duties – the husband has a duty & the wife has a duty – then there should not be any conflict. Marriage today is often seen as outdated and this has influenced some Muslims as well. A Lajna member asked for Huzoor’s(aba) perspective.

Huzoor(aba) said such disorders are spread through the influence of Dajjal & such immoral habits resulting from distancing oneself from religions will eventually have negative consequences. However, Huzoor(aba) said it is important to inform people through the

teachings of Islam regarding these such immoral lifestyles and said: *“It is our duty to explain and we must continue to do so.”*

A lady asked about what to do about Ahmadis who show disrespect towards the Jama’at & the Promised Messiah(as) but yet lacked the courage to leave the Jama’at?

Huzoor(aba) replied: *“Hypocrites have existed in every era,”* & that if their stance is overlooked by the Jama’at, it is done with the hope that they may reform but if their distorted behaviour starts to cause unrest within the Jama’at, then there remains the option for expulsion from the Jama’at.

Huzoor(aba) also stated it is the responsibility of individuals to bring to the Jama’at’s attention, of any inappropriate discourse taking place that the Jama’at may not be aware of so that an investigation can take place and appropriate action taken by the system of the Jama’at.

TASNEEF MEETING WITH HUZOOR(aba)

On the same day, the Tasneef Committee, some of whom had travelled especially from the USA, also met Huzoor(aba) in person. This Committee works on translations of the books of the Promised Messiah(as), children’s books & aspects of book production. They reported that 51 books out of 92 have been translated so far. Huzoor(aba) then instructed for various data to be collected.

JAMIA UK CONVOCATION CEREMONY

A day earlier, Huzoor(aba) attended the Jamia UK Convocation Ceremony & gave an address. 68 new missionaries graduated over the last 4 years and received their Shahid Degree certificates from Huzoor(aba)
